### Neighborhood Planning Initiative Needs Participants

Denver's Department of Community Planning and Development is initiating a Neighborhood Planning Initiative, which is a process expected to be completed within an 18 month period. The Neighborhood Planning Initiative will be concentrating on the Far Southwest Area Plan which is District 2 and includes our neighborhood.

Neighborhood plans are used as guidance and justification for approvals of rezonings, added density, development, transportation projects and other changes aimed at accommodating the population and employment growth the city expects over the next 20 years. The plan will look at such things as whether to add density in single-family neighborhoods, by allowing Accessory Dwelling Units, upzoning for duplex and four-unit buildings, or other means.

We are looking for 3 volunteers from Pinecrest Village to meet with the planning committee. It's important we get involved in decisions that can change the way our neighborhoods look.
