Japanese Beetles Get 0 Likes!

Homeowners who choose biological methods to control Japanese beetle populations can successfully use parasites, nematodes, funai, or other biologically based approaches. Some of these agents are commercially available to homeowners; others are not. While they take a little longer to produce the same results as insecticides. biological control agents last longer in the environment. More importantly, they do not adversely affect nontarget or potentially beneficial organisms.

<u>August Sky Watch –</u> <u>Perseid Meteor Shower</u>

The Perseid meteor shower runs from July 14 through September 1 in 2023, peaking in the pre-dawn hours of Sunday, August 13. The absolute maximum number of "shooting stars" per hour is 100, though normal rates seen in rural locations are more like 50-75 during the peak, according to the <u>American Meteor Society</u>.

Hiking Safety

Whether you're heading out for a day hike or an overnight adventure, hiking safety should be at the forefront of every trekker's mind.

No matter if you're a beginner or an experienced hiker, always check the weather forecast and prepare for sudden changes in weather with extra layers, spare water, sun protection and other day hiking essentials. Start with a sweat-wicking base layer that's breathable and regulates body temperature. Avoid cotton because in cold environments, wet cotton doesn't provide insulation, is slow to dry, and can make you even colder. In the heat, cotton traps warmth, which isn't ideal either. So try to steer clear of this material if you can. In any weather, staying well hydrated can help you avoid dehydration or even altitude sickness, but moreover, it simply helps you
