#### o 54-464:

- ☐ Do not park a truck more than 22 ft in length or a trailer not attached to a licensed vehicle for more than 2 hours on a public street
- □ Do not park a RV more than 22 ft in length, a truck and attached camper with combined length of more than 22 feet, or an auto/boat trailer attached to a licensed vehicle for more than 24 hours on street

☐ Do not park on the sidewalk or the sidewalk area
