Cold temperatures can affect both indoor and outdoor air quality.

As temperatures drop, carbon monoxide poisoning becomes a significant indoor winter hazard. Never use a gas stovetop or oven for heating.

Cold weather also affects outdoor air quality. Colder and drier winter air traps pollutants in Denver's skies. The outdoor burning of wood is prohibited in Denver without a permit, as it releases pollutants harmful to respiratory health and linked to other serious conditions. Propane, natural gas, and charcoal briquettes for grilling are allowed. You can also avoid unnecessary idling to reduce pollution, prevent theft, and extend your engine's life.

Protect our air by checking for Air Quality Action
Day alerts to stay aware of indoor burning restrictions from November to March. And check out the Love My Air app!
