Denver Code

- o 54-464:
- □ Do not park a truck more than 22 ft in length or a trailer not attached to a licensed vehicle for more than 2 hours on a public street
- □ Do not park a RV more than 22 ft in length, a truck and attached camper with combined length of more than 22 feet, or an auto/boat trailer attached to a licensed vehicle for more than 24 hours on street
- o 54-458:
- ☐ Do not park on the sidewalk or the sidewalk area

Pinecrest Covenant

15. VEHICLES. A ny boat, trailer, camper, truck, or unlicensed or unsightly old car shall be parked in the back yard and shall be concealed from the street by means of a fence or other acceptable screen.(Parking these vehicles in driveways is prohibited.)

Street Sweeping Season Has Arrived

Street sweeping season is from April to November. As a general rule in Council District 2 (with a few minor exceptions) everything north of Evans Avenue has a designated street sweeping day that is posted in neighborhoods and cars on those streets need to be moved on the posted day.

Where we are, south of Evans Avenue, is considered a non-posted area. This means, as time permits after sweeping posted areas first, the non-posted streets are swept. However, they are swept only in the months of April, June, August, October and November.

Please call 311 if there is broken glass, nails or something harmful in the street that needs to be cleaned up.
